## What makes good Christian tracts?

Christian tracts should be biblically sound. What do I mean by this? Biblically sound means that the tracts we produce follow the biblical pattern for the gospel message. That man must know he is a sinner and that he has offended the Most High God. He has committed treason by breaking God's law and deserves justice in hell. But God in His mercy sent Christ to live a perfect life, to die as a substitution, and to rise from the grave proving that His sacrifice is all-sufficient to save His people from the wrath of God—those who repent and believe in Jesus are called of God. Salvation is a free gift. No amount of good works we do will ever make up for our sin. Jesus paid it all! We broke the law; Jesus paid the fine. The ability to repent and believe Jesus even comes from God. Without God changing our hearts from darkness, we would never seek the light that is Jesus Christ. We need Jesus to save us, cleanse us, and redeem us!!

What I look for in a good tract is whether or not it contains the truth of Scripture in regards to the gospel of Jesus Christ. Below I list out the criterion, for what makes a good gospel tract.

- 1. Springboard
- 2. Sin
- 3. Righteousness
- 4. Judgment
- 5. The life of Jesus
- 6. The death of Jesus
- 7. The resurrection of Jesus
- 8. Repentance from sin
- 9. Faith in Jesus
- 10. Living for Jesus

The size of the gospel tract will determine the density of these topics and the depth of discussion. Christian tracts from Seedshakers.com will contain some form or fashion of these important truths. The gospel tracts are basically an exposition of 1 Corinthians 15:1-6.
